

Privacy Policy

Personal information is information that can be explicitly used to identify you, contact you as an individual, as a member or volunteer of the Uxbridge Scott Agricultural Society, or as a participant or vendor at the fair.

This includes your real name, email address, mailing address and phone numbers.

The Uxbridge Fall Fair collects personal information when you specifically and knowingly provide it to us.

Personal information enables the Uxbridge Scott Agricultural Society to notify you of the ongoing functions of the society. Personal information, in regards to members, such as your name, telephone number and email address may be published in various media when needed to identify a contact person for a specific event, with permission. Personal information relating to participants and or vendors may be used to inform you of upcoming events relating to the Uxbridge Scott Agricultural Society.

The Uxbridge Scott Agricultural Society will NOT release your personal information, other than described above, with these exceptions:

- When you give us permission to do so
- When we believe in good faith that the law requires it
- To protect the right or property of the Uxbridge Scott Agricultural Society

In the event of a claim for insurance, we may request further information from you.

Any personal information collected shall be kept confidential at all times except as already explained to you.

You may request a copy of personal information we have on hand.

The Uxbridge Scott Agricultural Society has reasonable security measures in place to protect against loss, misuse or interception by third parties. We will retain your information only for the time required and for the purposes mentioned earlier. The Uxbridge Scott Agricultural Society assumes no liability for interception, alteration or misuse of information transmitted to us over the internet, or misdirected by mail.

Photograph Policy

Please be advised that members or agents of the Uxbridge-Scott Agricultural Society (“U.S.A.S.”) will be taking photographs and videos for advertising and commercial use during the Uxbridge Fall Fair and other related Society activities. The U.S.A.S. reserves the exclusive right to photograph all participants, attendees, performers, exhibitors and volunteers (without exception). Your attendance at a U.S.A.S. event constitutes consent to be photographed for use in print or electronic publicity solely by the U.S.A.S.

To ensure the privacy of individuals and children, images will not be identified using full names or personal identifying information without written approval from the photographed subject, parent or legal guardian. If you object to your likeness being used in any form, please come to the Fair Office prior to the close of the Fair and provide your full name, address and telephone number and allow us to photograph you in order to have your likeness excluded. Forms may be obtained at the Uxbridge Public Library or Township Office before September 3rd.
